Jan Lauer has served the Athletic Training profession through her clinical, leadership, and volunteer experiences. She provided exceptional care for patients in an outpatient clinic setting. Jan served patients at Oakwood Sports Medicine (1986-1990), Oakwood Downriver Medical Center (1991-1993), and Tri-Rehab, Inc. (1994-present). In these experiences, Jan showed leadership by becoming the first Certified Athletic Trainer in Oakwood Sports Medicine's healthcare system and one of the first PT clinics owned by two Certified Athletic Trainers. Jan also served the Athletic Training Profession through her volunteerism as a BOC Examiner (1990-1999), MATS High School Committee Member (1990-1993), MATS Newspaper Chairperson (1994-1999), GLATA Secretary (1996-2000), MATS Fundraising Chairperson (1999-2003), MATS President-Elect (2003-2005), MATS President (2005-2007), and on the BOC Board of Directors (2011-2018). Jan has earned numerous accolades for her outstanding service to the Athletic Training Profession: MATS Distinguished Athletic Trainer (2000), NATA Service Award (2004), GLATA Distinguished AT Service Award (2005), GLATA Golden Pinnacle Award (2012), and NATA Distinguished Athletic Trainer Award (2015).
