Dennis Corbin has served the Athletic Training profession through his clinical experiences, leadership, and volunteering. He provided care for patients in the collegiate setting. Dennis showed considerable leadership during his 36-year tenure as the Head Athletic Trainer at Western Michigan University, making a difference in the lives of numerous student-athletes. Unfortunately, Dennis dealt with cancer in 2013 and ultimately passed away in 2018 due to complications from a stroke. The passing of Dennis was felt by family, numerous Athletic Trainers, former student-athletes from Western Michigan University, and Western Michigan University staff.
