Jeff Monroe has served the Athletic Training profession through his clinical experiences, leadership, and volunteering. He provided superb care for patients in the intercollegiate athletics setting. Jeff worked at the University of Minnesota as an Assistant Athletic Trainer (1975-1985) and served as both Head Athletic Trainer and Head Football Athletic Trainer at Michigan State University (1985-2013). Jeff's volunteer record also demonstrates service for the Athletic Training profession: Minnesota State Representative to GLATA (1978-1980), President to Minnesota Athletic Trainers Association (1981-1983), MATS Governmental Affairs Committee Chair for numerous years, NATA Ethics Committee member (1993), and GLATA Vice President (2000-2002). He also founded for the Big Sky Athletic Training Sports Medicine Conference in 1995 for professional development and networking. He still oversees the conference as the Executive Director to this day. Colleagues have described Jeff as "diligent, accomplished, and dedicated to the Athletic Training profession."
